

# RADCLIFF APRIL CLEAN-UP

April is Clean-up Month in the City of Radcliff. During the month of April, the City will be picking up from city **residential** areas, white goods (appliances including stoves, washers, dryers, hot water heaters, refrigerators, freezers, and air conditioners, but the **freon must be removed by a certified technician and bear the technician's certification tag**). Additionally the City will pick up batteries, tires, and paint sealed in its original container with readable labels. Used motor oil must be in a sealed container and clearly marked and labeled. **Hazardous material and liquids will not be picked up.**

This would be a great time to spruce up your property and also eliminate places where water collects to help reduce mosquito breeding grounds. These can be junk, tires, tins, buckets, pots and plastic containers.

Radcliff citizens should also be aware that stormwater that runs off of their property should be free from oil, gasoline, diesel, pesticides, fertilizers, and yard wastes. Keep our rivers, streams and waterways clean for drinking, fishing and swimming purposes.

Beginning April 1<sup>st</sup>, residents may call Radcliff Public Works at 351-8150, Monday through Friday during the hours of 8:00am and 4:00pm to arrange pickup. At the time of the call, residents should be prepared to inform the operator what items they have for pick-up. If you have questions about your items, please ask the operator when you call.

Waste Management will pick up items which cannot be recycled (mattresses, furniture, etc.) during April Clean-up free of charge. To arrange a pick-up of unwanted items, Waste Management customers should call their office toll free at 1-866-237-7019 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

**All items for pick-up must be placed curb-side and should not block sidewalks, streets or drainage areas.**
