

RADCLIFF DAYS PARADE-RULES AND SAFETY REGULATIONS

1. Entries must be received in Radcliff City Hall by **Friday September 9.** Your line-up position will be mailed to the contact person listed on the application.
2. The City of Radcliff reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.
3. **NO PARENT DROP OFF WILL BE ALLOWED ON STATE STREET, MEET AT THE Radcliff United Methodist Church parking lot at 275 S. Woodland Drive. After collecting your group, proceed to you designated spot. No vehicles will be allowed on State Street other than parade vehicles/floats.**
4. Increase supervision of children leaving your group to hand out candy, making sure they return to your group. All persons riding on floats/vehicles of any type shall be in a safe position.
5. All entries participate at their own expense and risk.
6. Children under the age of ten (10) may not participate unless accompanied by an adult. An appropriate number of adults must accompany youth/youth groups. Participants are responsible for the actions and conduct of those who are a part of their entry - before, during and after the parade.
7. All animals must be kept on leads under complete control in their assigned spots and must be kept off private property at all times. Pooper scoopers are required with all animal entries.
8. All participants are expected to abide by the instructions of those in charge of staging and line-up.
9. In case of inclement weather a rain date of October 8, 2011 has been established. A decision will be made within the two (2) hours of the start time of the parade and announcements will be made on radio stations: FM: WULF 94.3, WQXE 98.3, WRZI 101.5, WASE 103.5, WLVK 105.5, WKMO 106.3, WTHX 107.3 and AM station WIEL 1400; should cancellation be necessary.
10. In a community spirit, there will be no judging of entries in this parade nor will there be a review stand. This parade is strictly for community enjoyment.
